Director's Notes:

The characters in this play are not good people. They are spoiled, naive, duplicitous and cruel. They are beautiful and young, they guard their secrets and lash out when others get too close. They use sex and guilt as weapons against the people who love them most. It is not uncommon for children of breeding to feel entitled to whatever they want. For the lovers in this play, that privilege has no limits. I don't know why it's so much fun to watch rich kids in bathing suits behave so badly. Such shows are often 'guilty pleasures' for their devotees, something bad they like to do despite their inhibitions. For our young deviants, guilt is not an obstacle, but the inspiration for shameful acts. They use their shame to humiliate each other, and hope that in the end they won't feel bad at all.

This play is not a warning or a study in evil. It's cruel and it's perverse, but it's a love story, somewhere in its rotten heart. We hope that's how you like them.
